



This Office received your request to pump and haul wastewater on September 17, 1999. The wastewater is from the tank farm secondary containment system, tank farm loading/unloading bay, settling/separation unit, and vehicle wash-down area. The anticipated wastewater flow from these areas are approximately 300,000 gallons per year. Three existing 20,000 gallon above ground tanks will be use for storage of the wastewater. Crandall Corporation will haul the wastewater to either Water Recovery Systems in Charleston, SC or Waste Research & Recovery in Norcross, GA for ultimate disposal. After a review of the information provided, this Office hereby approves your request with the following conditions:

- The wastewater must meet all the conditions required by either Water Recovery Systems or Waste Research & Recovery.
- All transporting of wastewater shall be in accordance with rules and regulations of the State Department of Transportation and other agencies as applicable.
- 3) All sludges, waste oil and solid and hazardous waste shall be properly disposed of in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Bureau of Land and Waste Management.
- 5) A Best Management Practice (BMP) plan shall be developed and implemented for the wastewater storage tank and associated areas.
- 6) All records including the manifest should be retained for a minimum of three (3) years, or longer if requested by the Department. Upon request you shall furnish to the Department copies of records required to be kept.

Your most recent letter, dated January 18, 2001, requesting an extension to draft permit conditions number three (3) and four (4) has been reviewed. The Department is issuing the final permit contingent upon Crandall's compliance with the revised permit conditions. Again, item three (3) shall be in letterform that specifies all items that Crandall is not in compliance with and a timeframe on how long it will take Crandall to come into compliance with each issue. Item four (4) shall be an acceptable financial assurance mechanism in the amount of \$46,801.15 and be submitted to the attention of Michelle McCormick, Solid Waste Planning & Compliance. Keep in mind, non-compliance with these permit conditions would be a violation of your permit.

Also, receipt of your letter, dated January 8, 2001, commenting on the referenced subject's draft permit is acknowledged. Your request to reduce the amount of fencing around the perimeter of referenced facility is approved. Therefore, the proposed changes to page 11 and Figure 2, both in the engineering report, are acceptable. Enclosed is a permit for Crandall Corporation to continue operating the referenced facility as an industrial solid waste processing facility, in accordance with Regulation 61-107.6, Solid Waste Processing Facilities. In addition, enclosed is a stamped and approved set of the engineering plan and report that is to be kept on-site for reference, at all times.

It is recommended that in addition to the record keeping requirements, as stated in section F.2. of R. 61-107.6, all documentation from generators and landfill approvals associated with the disposal of solid waste shall be retained on-site and available to the Department, upon request. Keep in mind, any recovered materials that Crandall receives shall be managed in accordance with the Solid Waste Policy and Management Act of 1991. The definition of a recovered material states that a minimum of seventy five (75) percent by weight of the materials received shall be used, reused or recycled per calendar year.
